





WHAT IS HALLUX VALGUS?

Hallux Valgus, a common cause of 'bunion', is a bony lump that forms at the base of your big toe. If not detected and treated early, bunions can progressively worsen. There are both surgical and non-surgical treatments available, depending on the disease's progression.



SYMPTOMS



Pain and tenderness



Difficulty walking



Redness



Inflammation



Stiffness & restricted motion in the big toe



Hardened skin on the bottom of the foot and around the big toe

RISK FACTORS

- Wearing shoes that are too tight, narrow or pointed
- History of inflammatory arthritis
- History of injury or surgery
- Overuse from repetitive movements of the joint
- Foot mechanics or structural (affecting the way you walk)
